Requirements

- 130 credits for degree – 128 required credits and 2 free electives. Free electives are .5, 1, 2, or 3 credit courses in a subject area(s) of the student's choosing. These electives may be taken any semester.
- Maximum credit load of 18 per semester unless noted in professional semester.

- Shaded courses must be taken concurrently as a block of classes.
- When two courses are on the same line, take the course offered that year.
- Courses in **red** are offered both semesters and may be switched.
