

Requirements

- 130 credits for degree – 120 required credits and 10 free electives. Free electives are .5, 1, 2, or 3 credit courses in a subject area(s) of the student's choosing. These electives may be taken any semester.
- Maximum credit load of 18 per semester unless noted in professional semester.

Successful completion of this major and licensure requirements provides students eligibility for:

- WELS Assignment: Social Studies – Grades 5-12
- Minnesota Licensure: Social Studies – Grades 5-12
