

A minimum of 130 credits (128 required and 2 free elective credits in a subject area of the student's choosing) are required for degree. The maximum credit load is 18 per semester.

Shaded courses must be taken concurrently. Courses in red are offered both semesters and may be switched. Consult the catalog for courses required before student teaching.
