A minimum of 178 credits are required for this double major. The maximum credit load is 18 per semester.

Successful completion of this major and licensure requirements provides students eligibility for a WELS assignment to teach grades K-8 and mathematics in grades 5-12. Minnesota licensure provides eligibility to teach grades K-6 and mathematics in grades 5-12.
