A minimum of 133 credits (125 required and 5 free elective in a subject(s) area of the student's choosing) are required for this degree. The maximum credit load is 18 per semester.

Shaded courses must be taken concurrently. Courses in red are offered both semesters and may be switched. Consult the catalog for courses required before student teaching.

Successful completion of this major and licensure requirements provides students eligibility for a WELS assignment to teach social studies in grades 5-12. Minnesota licensure provides eligibility to teach social studies in grades 5-12. [Currently social studies is a non-licensable major for students new to the program.]
