If during the semester your class met on <u>Mondays</u> . . .	. . . you take your test in an <u>M</u> period . . .	. . . with the <u>number</u> of the hour in which your class met.	<b>M2</b> is the exam slot for a class that meets <b>MWF 2<sup>nd</sup></b> hour.
If during the semester your class met on <u>Tuesdays</u> or <u>Thursdays</u> (but never on Mondays) . . .	. . . you take your test in an <u>T</u> period . . .	. . . with the <u>number</u> of the hour in which your class met.	<b>T5 &amp; C</b> is the exam slot for a class that meets <b>T/Th</b> during <b>5<sup>th</sup></b> hour.
If during the semester your class met in a <u>block</u> . . .	. . . you take your test in a <u>block</u> period with the <u>letter</u> of the block in which your class met.		<b>T5 &amp; C</b> .is the exam slot for a class that meets in <b>C Block, T/Th</b> .
If during the semester your class met only on Wednesday and/or Fridays, 5 <sup>th</sup> or 6 <sup>th</sup> hour	. . . you take your test in an <u>W</u> period . . .	. . . with the <u>number</u> of the hour in which your class met.	<b>W5</b> is the exam slot for a class that meets <b>WF</b> during <b>5<sup>th</sup></b> hour.
