Paradigms*



- The system of beliefs through we filter experiences, input or information
- Biases, preconceptions, points of view
- Analogous to a lens
- The paradigm always comes first
- Data doesn't speak, it must be interpreted
- The paradigm we hold greatly influences the interpretation of the data
- Therefore all of science can be taken as evidence of evolution
