Nature and Purpose of the Award

This award, given by Mid-Minnesota United, is in honor and memory of Audrey Erskine, a long time advocate for teachers and education. It will provide a lasting remembrance while also investing in the future excellence of education. With this scholarship, an individual dedicated to becoming an outstanding classroom teacher will be recognized.

Mid-Minnesota United is offering a scholarship of up to \$500.00. The number of and amount of the scholarship(s) is contingent upon the availability of funds. The recipient of the scholarship award will be selected from junior and senior undergrads enrolled in a college or university, which prepares students for a teaching career at the preschool, elementary, or secondary level in Minnesota. The award is to be used at any accredited four-year college or university, and is to be applied toward tuition, lodging, books, or any other necessary educational expense.

Qualifications

The MMU/Audrey Erskine Scholarship Award Committee will seek to evaluate the following applicant qualifications:

(1) work habits; (2) character and personality; (3) leadership; (4) a sincerity of intention to teach; and, (5) membership in the Education Minnesota Student Program (EMSP) is preferred. EMSP membership will be verified before scholarships are awarded.

Application and Selection Procedures

The completed application must be submitted to the MMU/Audrey Erskine Scholarship Award Committee **by June 3, 2019.** Priority in choosing recipients will be given to those candidates pursuing a Minnesota teaching license. The name of the award recipient will be announced by September 23, 2019. Applicants not selected will only be informed in writing of the results of their applications if a self-addressed, postage-paid envelope is enclosed with their application.
