



The Baumann Public School Scholarship Opportunity

- Incoming first-year student who attended and graduated from a public high school in the United States with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Open to those studying to be a pastor or teacher
 - One scholarship for Pastoral Ministry, one scholarship for Education Ministry (elementary or secondary), and one scholarship for Early Childhood Ministry
- Scholarships may be renewed for a student's remaining years as long as the GPA is met and funding is available.
- Winners are selected based on their responses to the essay topic. *Names are removed from the essay before the Financial Aid Committee reviews the application to ensure non-preferential selection.*
- Scholarships are awarded in fall

To apply, prepare an application addressed to the Financial Aid Committee. Submit your application electronically to the Financial Aid Office: scholarships@mlc-wels.edu no later than **September 15, 2025**.

On the top portion of your application, provide:

- Your name
- Scholarship name
- Cumulative GPA
- Education Major(s)
- Word count for your essay
- Bullet point that applies to you

Graduate of a public school

Submit a short essay (limited to 500 words).
