

## By Grace Scholarship Opportunity

- This scholarship is open to **Staff Ministry** and **Pre-Seminary** students **who have dependent children**, are in good academic standing, and have unique gifts to be used in God's Kingdom. Students must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credits.
- Award Amount: \$1750
- Winners are selected based on their responses to the essay topic. Names are removed from the essay before the Financial Aid Committee reviews the application to ensure non-preferential selection.

To apply, prepare an application addressed to the Scholarship Committee. The material used to demonstrate this information can include (but are not limited to): a paper, a song, a poem, a pantomime, or a picture. Submissions may be on paper, video, or other appropriate medium.

Applications will be reviewed and the scholarship awarded by the selection committee on the basis of:

- The student's attitude and commitment to full-time service in God's Kingdom as demonstrated in his/her daily life and academic dedication.
- The quality and message of the student's submission project.
- The subjective opinion of the selection committee members concerning how likely the student is to become a productive and effective called worker.
