Martin Luther College agrees to match the Congregational Partner Grant **up to \$1,750** per student once each academic year.

By signing this agreement, the congregation's representatives attest to the following:

- **Deadline for submission is July 15, 2026. Submissions postmarked after July 15, 2026, will be credited to the student's account as a congregational grant but will not receive the MLC match.** Late applications will be accepted for students not attending the fall semester. Deadline for students admitted for the spring semester is December 15, 2026.
- Monies remitted for matching come from the church's annual budget, endowed sources, or donations to a specific fund. If a specific fund has been created, neither the students nor the students' family members can have contributed to this fund with the intent of receiving a tax benefit.
- Monies must accompany this form to be considered formally submitted.
- Congregation monies will be applied to the fall semester, and MLC matching funds will be applied to the spring semester. *MLC will return church funds for any student who withdraws prior to completing 60% of their first semester/trimester.*
- Students enrolled in APPLE (Alternative Pathway to Professional Licensure Eligibility) will have MLC matching funds applied to the second and third trimesters. Submission deadline for APPLE students starting in the spring trimester is December 15, 2026. Deadline for those starting in the summer trimester is April 15, 2027. *If any terms of the APPLE program are not completed, the match will not be applied. Students must be enrolled in at least six credits to be eligible for the CPGP program.*
