- * completion of the six undergraduate theology courses required for certification as a staff minister or a teacher, or comparable undergraduate coursework approved by the graduate faculty.
- * an undergraduate degree in education from an accredited college or university
- * an undergraduate GPA of 3.00 or an average of at least 3.00 for no fewer than nine semester hours of graduate credit at an accredited graduate institution.
- * completed application, written statement of goals, and \$35 registration fee.
- * Students that do not have a 3.00 undergraduate GPA may also be accepted into the program on the condition that they attain a 3.00 or higher GPA on their first nine graduate credits.
