- Completion of the six undergraduate theology courses required for certification as a staff minister or a teacher, or comparable undergraduate coursework approved by the graduate faculty.
- An undergraduate degree in education from an accredited college or university.
- An undergraduate GPA of 3.00 or an average of at least 3.00 for no fewer than nine semester hours of graduate credit at an accredited graduate institution.
- Completed application, written statement of goals, and \$35 application fee.
- Students that do not have a 3.00 undergraduate GPA may also be accepted into the program on the condition that they attain a 3.00 or higher GPA on their first nine graduate credits.
- Previous undergraduate theology requirements:
  - ◊ MLC's 18-credit Ministry Certification courses
  - ◊ Satisfactory completion of theology graduation
  - ◊ Satisfactory completion of theology requirements from another Lutheran college with MLC MATS faculty approval
