

Placing Holds in MNLINK

Q MNLINK Catalog searches library catalogs throughout Minnesota.

Why: To find an item that is not held at the MLC library or other TdS libraries. How: Use MNLINK, Minnesota Libraries.

Note: Always check the MLC/TdS catalog before using MNLINK. It is much faster to receive items from local libraries than it is to use MNLINK.

Access MNLINK using one of these methods:

- Through the library website: <u>https://mlc-wels.edu/library</u>
 - Click on the MNLINK Catalog Link, OR
- Select, Search and Find Library Resources Books MNLINK Library Catalog, or
- Access MNLINK at <u>http://www.mnlink.org</u>.
- Enter your search term, and search either a specific library system, or all of them. Be patient. It can take a few minutes to search all of the libraries in Minnesota.
