

Accessing Specific E-Journal Issues

Why: To search for articles in a specific issue of an online journal


How: Use the Advanced Search feature.

Access a database using one of these methods:

- Through the MLC Library website, http://mlc-wels.edu/library
 - o Click on Search and Find on the left, the Databases A-Z.
 - Choose the database you'd like to use.
- Through the MLC Library website, http://mlc-wels.edu/library
 - o Click on the e-Journals tab, then search for the journal title you're looking for.
 - Choose one of the databases that contains the journal.
 - o On the Publication Details page, click on Search within this publication.

Choose the Advanced Search link under the search box.

The journal name may be pre-populated . . .



In the Search Options section of the page, enter the dates you're looking for.



Click on the Search button (at the top) without entering any additional search terms.

You will receive a list of the articles from that journal issue.



Click on a title for more information about the article, or click on one of the full-text links to go directly to the article. (Note: Right-clicking and opening in a new tab may not work properly. Use a regular left-click to open these links.)
