

Accessing Specific E-Journal Issues

Why: To search for articles in a specific issue of an online journal

How: Use the Advanced Search feature.

Access a database using one of these methods:

- Through the MLC Library website, <http://mlc-wels.edu/library>
 - Click on *Search and Find* on the left, the *Databases A-Z*.
 - Choose the database you'd like to use.
- Through the MLC Library website, <http://mlc-wels.edu/library>
 - Click on the e-Journals tab, then search for the journal title you're looking for.
 - Choose one of the databases that contains the journal.
 - On the Publication Details page, click on *Search within this publication*.

Choose the *Advanced Search* link under the search box.

The journal name may be pre-populated . . .
