

Overdrive eBooks and eAudio

Why: Check out free electronic books and audiobooks.

How: Use Overdrive.

General Overdrive Information:

• Overdrive has downloadable e-books and e-audiobooks, similar to Kindle or Audible, but they're free.

- MLC users have access to two collections: Martin Luther College <u>martinluther.overdrive.com</u> and Traverse des Sioux Cooperative <u>tds.overdrive.com</u>. Find links to both in the "Quick Links" section toward the bottom of the MLC Library website.
- There are two mobile apps available for Overdrive: the older Overdrive app, and the newer, easier-to-use Libby app. Search for Martin Luther College or Traverse des Sioux Cooperative as your library name. In Libby, you can have both libraries set up so you don't have to keep re-entering your login information.
- Many ebooks can be read on a Kindle or with a Kindle app; you need an Amazon account for this. Others can be read or listened to from within the Overdrive or Libby app.
- Account login for Overdrive and Libby is the same as your library account barcode and password. If you haven't already set up a password for your library account, do that first:
 - o Go to tdslib.iii.com.
 - Click on the Login link in the top right corner.
 - o Enter your student ID barcode, and leave the password field blank.
 - Click Submit; then you'll be prompted to choose a password.
 - Use that barcode number and password to log in to Overdrive and/or Libby.

Using Overdrive:

- Browse or search to find an item that you want to check out. You can search from a web browser or from the Overdrive or Libby app.
- For most items, you can choose to borrow for 7, 14, or 21 days.
- Only one person at a time can have a particular book checked out. If the item you want is already checked out, you can place a hold on the item and be notified when it is available for you.
- You may have to download and set up Adobe Digital Editions or set up an Amazon account in order to read certain titles.
- If you finish a book early, you can return the book early. Otherwise, it will be returned automatically at the end of your loan period and you will no longer be able to access it. You will never have fines when using Overdrive.
- You may check out a maximum of five items from each collection (MLC and TdS) at a time.
- Audiobooks will be found in the Overdrive or Libby app under Loans.
