We are thankful that our on-campus and online enrollments have held steady from last year. NONTRADITIONAL EDUCATION

MLC's Competency-Based Education program is specifically designed to support returning adult learners who have completed some college courses and may even have a degree but do not have a baccalaureate degree in education. STUDENT EDUCATIONAL DEBT AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

For the sixth straight year, the average amount of debt incurred by MLC graduates who graduate with debt has declined. One significant component of that decline is MLC's Congregational Partner Grant Program (CPGP). Students participating in the CPGP program can reduce their college debt by \$2,900 for this school year. You can find those details on the second page of the MLC Report.
