

## Engelbrecht, Maasz Win Player of the Week

Volleyball players **Rebecca Engelbrecht** (*Shoreland*) and **Miranda Maasz** (*MVL*) won UMAC Player of the Week honors this week.

Engelbrecht won Offensive Player of the Week for the second time this season, averaging 6.33 kills per set in two matches. Against Minnesota-Morris on Friday night, Engelbrecht set a new career high with 32 kills.

Maasz won Setter of the Week for the first time this season. She averaged 12.9 assists per set, and had at least 54 assists in both matches over the weekend. Maasz also tied the school record for assists in a match with 62 against Minnesota-Morris.

The football team fell behind early and was unable to overcome the deficit in a 47-26 loss at Northwestern last weekend.


