Holzhueter Scores 1,000th Career Point

Junior forward **Galen Holzhueter** (*MVL*) became the ninth player in the history of the MLC men's basketball program to score 1,000 points for his career in Friday's game against St. Scholastica.

Holzhueter entered Friday's game needing 12 points to reach 1,000, and finished with 20 points. He also finished with 13 rebounds, three assists, and two blocks to help the Knights to an 83-77 win.

Holzhueter is the second junior at MLC to score 1,000 points, joining Tom Engelbrecht '04. He also became the second member of his family to reach the milestone, joining his brother Greg Holzhueter '11.

The women's basketball team came back from a tough loss Friday night against St. Scholastica to beat Northland 57-47 Saturday.

The Knights overcame a tough shooting night (35.7 percent) with the help of a swarming defense that forced 26 turnovers (leading to 21 MLC points) and held Northland to 29.2 percent shooting.

Brittney Gossen (*Manitowoc LHS*) led three MLC players in double figures with 14 points, while **Hannah Hackbarth** (*Lakeside*) and **Leah Nass** (*Manitowoc LHS*) each finished with 11 points.

With the win, MLC improved to 3-2 in conference play and 5-11 overall.
