## Brassow, Tessmer Named All-UMAC

**Todd Brassow** (*MLS*) and **Matthew Tessmer** (*MVL*) were each named All-UMAC for their performances for the men's track team at the UMAC Outdoor Track & Field Championships last week.

Brassow won the High Jump competition for the second consecutive season, jumping 1.9 meters, while Tessmer took second place in the 400 Meter Dash with a time of 51.54. The top two finishes helped MLC finish fourth in the team competition.

The women finished fifth at the event. **Emilee Koltz** (*LPS*) and **Hannah Hackbarth** (*Lakeside*) each took home a third place finish to lead the way.

## Waldek Named All-Conference after Record-Breaking Season



Waldek gets another hit

Junior outfielder **Emily Waldek** (*Trumbull CN*) was named First Team All-UMAC in softball after setting a new MLC single-season record with 50 hits this season.

Waldek finished second in the UMAC with a .481 batting average for the season, and led MLC with 33 runs scored, 12 doubles, three triples, and a .533 on-base percentage. Waldek was also named to the All-Defensive team by the UMAC coaches for her strong play in center field.

Outfielder **Sara Willems** (*Lakeside*) received Honorable Mention All-UMAC recognition after setting a new MLC single-season record with eight home runs. She also led the team with 32 runs batted in.

## Ziel Sets New MLC Strikeout Record

Senior **Jake Ziel** (*LPS*) set a new MLC career record for strikeouts in a start against UM-Morris on April 25, and finished his career on May 6 with 205 strikeouts.

The left-hander also set the new MLC record for innings pitched in a career with 200.2, and ranks second in school history with 14 career wins.

Earlier this season, Ziel recorded his 100<sup>th</sup> career hit, a milestone that was also reached by teammate **Aaron Stokke** (*SCLHS*). **Galen Holzhueter** (*MVL*) finished his career with the MLC records for career triples (nine) and stolen bases (33), and tied the single-season record for stolen bases (15) this season.
