

Football Closes Season with 28-21 Loss

The football team closed its season with a 28-21 loss to Westminster in the season finale.

The Knights came back from a 14-0 deficit in the first half to take a 21-14 lead heading into the fourth quarter, but were unable to hold that lead after sustaining several key injuries on the offensive side of the ball.

First-year runner **Eddie Endicott** (*LPS*) was the leading offensive threat on the day with 18 carries for 109 yards and one touchdown. **Joe Rodewald** (*LPS*) also had a rushing touchdown in the game, while seniors **Ben Hansen** (*Luther*) and **Nick Kressin** (*WISCO*) each had interceptions to lead the defensive effort.
