

Jonathan Kock Wins Pitcher of the Week

Sophomore **Jonathan Kock** (*LPS*) was named UMAC Pitcher of the Week in baseball following his performance against Northwestern in a 4-0 MLC win on Friday, April 3.

Kock started the game and pitched all nine innings, scattering seven hits and striking out six without walking a batter. It marked the first shutout of his collegiate career, and dropped his ERA to a team-best 3.00 for the season after four appearances.

The win improved Kock's record to 2-1 this season. Along with his team-leading ERA,

he also leads MLC in innings pitched (21.0) and strikeouts (13). At the plate, Kock is batting .255 this season with five runs scored and five runs batted in.

Doell has also been good at the plate, along with first-year shortstop **Megan Lemke** (*Shoreland*) and junior outfielder **Maggie Schultz** (*Luther*).
