

Marquardt Sets Wins Record at UNW

Junior **Kathryn Marquardt** (*Shoreland*) set a new MLC softball record for most wins by a pitcher with her 27th career win last weekend at Northwestern.

The 3-1 win moved MLC into fourth place in the UMAC standings with four games left on the conference schedule. MLC will battle fifth-place Crown College in three of those games, with the fourth and final spot in the UMAC Postseason Tournament on the line.

Marquardt currently leads MLC in wins (eight), strikeouts (38), and ERA (3.9) this season. She also ranks second on the MLC career list in innings pitched (325.2) and third in strikeouts (112).

Todd Brassow (*MLS*) broke his own school record in the High Jump with a jump of 6'9.75", which is tied for the sixth-highest jump in Division III this outdoor season.

Katie Zietlow (*LPS*) set a pair of records for the women. She broke her own record in the 400 Meter Hurdles with a time of 1:12.73, and then set a new mark in the Javelin Throw with a throw of 37.4 meters.

Rachel Winter (*Manitowoc Lutheran*) also set a new record for the women in the 400 Meters with a time of 1:01.13.
