

## Swanson, Mauer Earn Player of the Week Honors

Soccer players **Jenna Maurer** (*LPS*) and **Aaron Swanson** (*SCLHS*) each received UMAC Offensive Player of the Week honors for their performances last week.

Maurer won the honor in women's soccer after setting a new career high with four goals in an 11-0 win over Finlandia on September 9. Maurer leads MLC with four goals this season, and has moved into fifth place in program history with 30 goals for her career.

Swanson earned his award in men's soccer after scoring three goals last week in two games, one of which was a 4-3 win over Finlandia. Swanson's four goals this season are the most on the team through the first five games.
