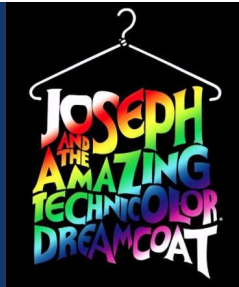
You're Invited . . . to Come Together
