
Bitter Sets New School Record

First-year runner **Ben Bitter** (*WISCO*) set a new MLC men's track and field record in the 3000 Meter Steeplechase on Saturday with a time of 9:40.37 at the Carleton Relays.

Bitter's time was good enough to take first place in the event and broke the previous school record set back in 1996 by nearly 12 seconds. The time was also the fastest of any UMAC runner in the event this season, and earned Bitter the honor of UMAC Track Athlete of the Week.

Bitter also ran the anchor leg of the Knights' 4x400 Meters relay team, and has put together strong performances in the 800 and 1500 Meters this season.
