The women's basketball team picked up its first win of the season Friday at Crown as part of a weekend split in conference play. The Knights topped Crown 73-30 and lost 65-52 at UM-Morris on Saturday.

The Knights dominated Crown in Friday's win, holding the Storm to 18.5 percent shooting from the field. **Jade St. Germaine** (*LPS*) led MLC with 21 points to go with eight rebounds and three blocks.
