

Schultz Scores 1,000th Career Point

Senior guard **Grace Schultz** (*FVL*) became the third player in MLC women's basketball program history to score 1,000 career points in Monday's game against UW-Stout.

Schultz entered the game needing three points to reach the milestone. She finished with 24 points, 11 rebounds, five assists, and four steals in the 11-point defeat.

Schultz now ranks third in program history with 1,021 career points, and also ranks in the top six in career field goals (third), steals (fourth), three-point field goals (sixth), and rebounds (sixth). She joins Erica Babinec ('12) and Emma Babinec ('06) as the only players to score at least 1,000 career points.

The Knights dominated the game from start to finish and outscored GLCC all four quarters. Grace Schultz (*FVL*) led MLC with 16 points. Hailey Johnson (*FVL*) and Jade St. Germaine (*LPS*) each scored nine points, while Cassandra Anklam (*MLS*) and Kati Aguilar (*CLHS*) finished with eight points apiece off the bench.

The Knights enter Wednesday's UMAC opener at North Central with a record of 2-6 on the season. The Knights finish the month of December with four straight conference games, three of which are on the road. The lone home contest will be against Bethany Lutheran on Wednesday, December 13.
