Rothe Moves to Second in Career Assists

Senior guard **Luke Rothe** (*LPS*) moved into second place in program history with 367 career assists, just three shy of the record held by his coach, Greg Holzhueter '11.

Rothe holds the MLC single-season record with 137 during his sophomore season (2013-14) and finished his first three seasons third in program history with 323 career assists, but missed the 2015-16 season due to injury. This season, Rothe ranks second on the team with 44 assists (3.1 per game) to go with 7.6 points per game.

Earlier this season, Rothe became the 11th player in program history to score at least 1,000 career points.
