## Maurer Earns NSCAA Academic Honor

Senior women's soccer player **Jenna Maurer** (*LPS*) was named a National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) Scholar Athlete recipient for her work on the field and in the classroom this season.

Maurer was named a Third Team All-North/Central Region Scholar Athlete after scoring a team-high 13 goals and 29 points on the field, while also compiling a 3.9 grade point average (GPA) off the field.

Maurer finished her career third in program history with 49 career goals, and is one of four players in program history to record at least 100 career points.

The men's basketball team was unable to overcome the size and depth of a strong Viterbo team in a 91-69 defeat on Tuesday, but showed signs of getting things going on the offensive end in defeat.

The Knights finished with their best output of the season beyond the three-point arc, making 13 of 24 attempts and setting new season highs in both makes and percentage.

First-year guard **Nate Lindloff** (*MLS*) led the way with 15 points and made five of his six attempts from beyond the arc. **TJ Babinec** (*Luther*) added 14 points, while **Josh Tomlin** (*LPS*) scored ten off the bench and made both of his three-pointers.

The Knights return to conference play this weekend at rival Bethany Lutheran College.
