The softball team earned three wins on March 18 at the Plymouth Dome to improve its record to 3-8 this season. The Knights won all three games in five innings, topping Maranatha Baptist by the scores of 11-2 and 8-0, and defeating North Central 14-1.

Jessica Friebe (*MLS*) led the MLC offense with a .625 batting average, eight runs scored, and five stolen bases. Since her return to the field from the basketball court, Friebe is batting .533 with 11 runs scored in five starts as the team's catcher.

Megan Lemke (*Shoreland*) had a strong day at the plate with an inside-the-park home run and five runs batted in, and **Rachel Haugly** (*WLA*) and **Kelli Doell** (*FVL*) also drove in five runs. **Kathryn Marquardt** (*Shoreland*), **Amanda Schoch** (*MLS*), and Doell each earned wins on the mound.

Osterman started the trip 10-10 at the plate, and finished the seven games down south with a teambest .522 batting average and seven runs scored.

Through the first nine games this season, Osterman leads the Knights in hits (12), runs (7), slugging percentage (.455) on-base percentage (.433), and total bases (13).
