

Kock Named Pitcher of the Week

Senior **Jon Kock** (*LPS*) was named UMAC Pitcher of the Week in baseball for his performance in the season opener against Finlandia on March 3.

Kock pitched a complete game, allowing only one run on seven hits in seven innings while striking out ten. He also helped his own cause at the plate, giving MLC the lead in the first inning with an RBI single.

With that win, Kock moved into third place on the Knights' all-time records list with 12 career wins. He also ranks among the program's leaders in career innings pitched (170.2) and earned run average (4.27).
