The baseball team earned its first wins of the UMAC season with a doubleheader sweep of Northland on April 28 by the scores of 7-5 and 10-9.

The Knights built a 7-1 lead after five innings of game one before holding on for the 7-5 win. **Dillon Solomon** (*MLS*) earned his first win of the season with six strong innings, while **Noah Panzer** (*Northland LHS*) scored his first career save in relief.
