Marquardt Closes Record-Breaking Career

Senior softball pitcher **Kathryn Marquardt** (*Shoreland*) closed her career by breaking her third MLC record Monday against St. Olaf.

Marquardt, who already held the MLC records for career wins (31) and innings pitched (427.2), set the school's career strikeout record with 148. That broke the previous record of 147 held by Laura Miller '13.

Marquardt served as the team's ace all four seasons, finishing with a 31-35 record and an ERA of 4.59. This season, Marquardt posted a record of 4-10 for the Knights, who finished 9-20 overall and 5-11 in conference play.

Track Teams Set for UMAC Championships

The men's and women's track team are set for this weekend's UMAC Outdoor Track and Field Championships at Minnesota Morris.

The men competed in the final tune-up of the season at Gustavus on Saturday. **Todd Brassow** (*MLS*) tied for first place in the High Jump. **Martin Loescher** (*KMLHS*) took fourth in the Javelin Throw, and **Jonathan Fleischmann** (*Austin MN*) led all MLC runners with a third place finish in the 5000 Meters.

The women also competed at Gustavus, with **Katie Zietlow** (*LPS*) and **Rylee Weisensel** (*MVL*) leading the way with top five finishes in the High Jump. **Charlotte Huebner** (*Lakeside*) also had a strong showing in the Javelin, finishing sixth. The women have one final event at St. Thomas on Wednesday before the conference meet.

The women's tennis team closed the regular season with a pair of wins over Bethany Lutheran College to finish the UMAC season with a 6-4 record.
