

## Volleyball Tops CSS in UMAC Quarterfinal

The volleyball team advanced to the semifinal round of the UMAC Postseason Tournament with a five-set win over St. Scholastica in Monday's quarterfinal.

The Knights fell behind 1-0 after the Saints made a big comeback to win the first game, but won three of the final four sets to win the match.

MLC finished the match with 80 kills, the highest total by the team since the 2006 season. Jade St. Germaine (*LPS*) recorded 26 of those kills to give her the highest single-match total by an MLC player since the 2013 season. Kira Grev (*SCLHS*), Rylee Weisensel (*MVL*), and Moriah Hackbarth (*Lakeside*) each had at least 14 kills.
