

Schultz Wins UMAC Player of the Week

Senior guard **Grace Schultz** (*FVL*) was named UMAC Women's Basketball Player of the Week on November 20 after a strong start to the season.

Schultz helped the Knights to a 1-2 record in the opening week by averaging 15.3 points and 10.3 rebounds per game while also leading the team with 14 steals and seven assists.

Schultz's strong start has moved her up the career rankings in a number of statistics in MLC women's basketball program history. Schultz now ranks third with 973 career points, and also moved into fifth place with 190 career steals. She also ranks just outside the top five in career rebounds and three-point field goals.

The women's basketball team earned its first win of the season by the score of 69-60 over Augsburg College on Friday, November 17.

The Knights trailed 33-31 at the half, but used a strong defensive performance in the second half to outscore the Auggies by 11 points on the way to the nine-point win.

Grace Schultz (*FVL*) led the charge on both ends of the court for MLC with 18 points, 13 rebounds and five steals. **Jade St. Germaine** (*LPS*) added 14 points and 12 rebounds, while **Hailey Johnson** (*FVL*) set a new career high with 14 points.

The Knights are currently 1-4 on the season as they head into this weekend's twogame trip to Michigan to play at Calvin College and Great Lakes Christian College.
