



Football Ends Season With 5-5 Record

The football team closed its season with a 5-5 record following a 63-26 loss to UMAC-champion Eureka on November 4.

The Knights opened the game on offense with a pair of long touchdowns, but were unable to keep pace with the Red Devils' high-powered attack in the second half.

Sophomore quarterback **Ian Paulsen** (*LPS*) opened the game with a 73-yard touchdown strike to **Josh Arndt** (*SCLHS*), and then recorded a career long 73-yard touchdown run on the next possession. **Nate Stein** (*LPS*) and **Elliott Butler** (*Lakeside*) also scored rushing touchdowns in the game for MLC.

Joe Graumann (*Lakeside*) and **Elijah Kroll** (*Kumba, Cameroon*) were named Second Team All-UMAC, while **Luke Meihack** (*WLA*) and **Ethan Schultz** (*LPS*) each earned honorable mention. This was the second straight season Joe Graumann earned Second Team honors.
