## Maurer Records 100 Career Points

Senior forward **Jenna Maurer** (*LPS*) became the fourth MLC women's soccer player to record at least 100 points in her career this season.

Maurer reached the milestone with two goals and one assist in a 4-3 defeat against Buena Vista on September 28. Since that game, she added three goals and one assist in a 5-0 win over North Central on October 8, and now has a team-leading 12 goals and 26 points this season.

For her career, Maurer ranks third in program history with 48 goals, and fourth with 109 points. She also has two of the top ten goal-scoring seasons in program history.

The golf teams finished the fall season at the UMAC Golf Championships at Alexandria Golf Club last week.

The men finished the three-day tournament in eighth place with a final team score of 1013. Senior **Josh Hansen** (*Luther*) finished tied for fourth place with a final score of 233 (+17), and was named All-UMAC for the fourth consecutive season.

The women finished sixth at the event with a total score of 1368. First-year **Alison Lindemann** (*LPS*) tied for ninth with a score of 295 (+79).

Hansen and Lindemann were also recipients of the Sportsmanship Award, given to one player from each team who best exemplifies sportsmanship during the season.
