Women's Soccer Clinches UMAC Tourney Berth

The women's soccer team clinched a berth in the UMAC Postseason Tournament over the weekend despite a tough loss to conference-leading Northwestern on October 21.

The Knights are currently tied for third place in the conference with 19 points thanks to a 6-3-1 UMAC record.

Defense continues to lead the way for MLC. The Knights have allowed 0.8 goals per game in conference play, with three of those goals coming on penalty kicks. Sophomore **Morgan Hill** (*LPS*) leads the team with five goals and three assists during the team's ten UMAC games.

Grev Reaches 1,000 Digs Milestone

Senior outside hitter **Kira Grev** (*SCLHS*) continued to put her name in the MLC volleyball program record books when she recorded her 1,000th career dig in the team's match against Minnesota Morris on October 17.

Grev is the tenth player in program history to reach the milestone, and also became just the third MLC player with at least 1,000 career kills and digs, joining former MLC stars Lisa Gawrisch ('00) and Rebecca Engelbrecht ('13) as members in that exclusive club.

On Saturday, October 21, Grev and the Knights clinched a berth in the UMAC Postseason Tournament with a three-set sweep of Northland College. This marks the eighth straight season the Knights have reached the conference tournament.
