Feddersen Named Player of the Week

Women's soccer goalkeeper **Erin Feddersen** (*Great Mills MD*) was named UMAC Defensive Player of the Week following a pair of shutouts against UMAC opponents North Central and UW-Superior.

Feddersen stopped nine total shots in the two games, and currently leads the UMAC in goals against average (0.45) and save percentage (.903).

The Knights have now recorded five straight shutouts as a team and have a 4-0-1 record during that stretch. The shutout streak is tied for longest in program history with the 2002 team that finished the season with five straight clean sheets.

Football Tops Greenville 34-20

The football team earned its first-ever win over Greenville College by the score of 34-20 on Saturday to improve to 3-1 this season.

The Knights showed great balance against the Panthers as they unleashed their most productive passing day of the season. First-year quarterback **Zach Bloomquist** (*WISCO*) completed 14 of 20 passes for 229 yards and three touchdowns. Junior receiver **Josh Arndt** (*SCLHS*) earned UMAC Offensive Player of the Week honors after catching five passes for 138 yards and three scores.

Defensively, MLC sacked the Panthers five times and forced two turnovers. **Jake Kieselhorst** (*LPS*) finished with ten tackles, two sacks, and one forced fumble. **Dan Gensmer** (*MLS*) finished with two sacks and six tackles.
