

Brassow Reaches 1,000 Point Milestone

Senior **Todd Brassow** (*MLS*) became the tenth MLC men's basketball player to score at least 1,000 career points in the Knights' game at Finlandia on January 3.

Brassow has improved each year during his career. He scored only 50 points in his first season, but improved his points per game average to 12.2 as a sophomore, and then 17.2 points per game on his way to First Team All-UMAC honors as a junior.

This season, Brassow ranks tenth in NCAA Division III in scoring with an average of 24.7 points per game. He has scored at least 32 points in three of his last four games, including an MLC single-game record 45 points against Crown College on Friday.

The women's basketball team improved its UMAC record to 5-3 at the midpoint of the conference season with wins against Crown and Minnesota-Morris last weekend.

The Knights defeated Crown 77-50 on Friday, thanks to a strong defensive performance that held the Storm to 25.0 percent shooting from the field. **Jessica Friebe** (*MLS*) and **Mariah Schoof** (*MVL*) led the team with 11 and 10 points, respectively.

On Saturday, the Knights snapped a six-game losing streak to UMM with a 56-50 win. Defense once again carried the Knights to victory, as they held the Cougars to 31.6 percent shooting and forced 18 turnovers. **Leah Nass** (*Manitowoc LHS*) led the team with 14 points and 11 rebounds. **Grace Schultz** (FVL) added 12 points to go with three assists.

Todd Brassow (*MLS*) scored a school-record 45 points, 43 of which came in regulation. **T.J. Babinec** (*Luther*) added 22 points, while senior wing **J.D. Uhlhorn** (*ALA*) scored a career-high 21 points on 7-9 shooting from the field off the bench.

Uhlhorn forced overtime with three free throws at the end of regulation after time expired, and scored 19 of his 21 points after halftime.
