

Schultz Continues Record Book Climb

Women's senior basketball player **Grace Schultz** (*FVL*) continues her climb up the MLC record books in several statistical categories, thanks to a strong season.

After becoming the third player in program history to score at least 1,000 career points earlier this season, Schultz now ranks third in program history in career steals (227) and field goals (421). She also ranks fourth in rebounds (596) and fifth in both free throws (202) and three-point field goals (91).

Schultz has 59 steals through 16 games this season, putting her on pace to break the program's single-season record of 84.

MLC will open its season with a trip to Florida starting on March 5. The Knights will play eight games during the trip.
