



DeNoyer Leads Knights to 80-72 Win

Sophomore guard **Austin DeNoyer** (*Lakeside*) tied career highs with 24 points and 11 rebounds to lead the men's basketball team to an 80-72 win over Finlandia on Sunday.

DeNoyer made nine of his 11 shots from the field and three of his five attempts from beyond the three-point arc in the win. It marked the second straight game in which he scored 24 points.

Three other MLC players joined DeNoyer in double figures in the win. **Nate Lindloff** (*MLS*) made five three-pointers on the way to 17 points, while **Richard Eckmann** (*Trimont MN*) and **Ian Paulsen** (*LPS*) finished with 16 and 14 points, respectively.

Grace Schultz Named UMAC Player of the Week

Senior guard **Grace Schultz** (*FVL*) was named UMAC Women's Basketball Player of the Week for the second time this season on Monday.

Schultz earned the honor after averaging 25.0 points, 10.0 rebounds, 4.5 assists, and 3.5 steals per game in a pair of games against the top two teams in the current UMAC standings.

This season, Schultz leads MLC in points per game (16.3), steals (75), and assists (54). She also ranks second on the team in rebounds per game (8.5), while her 75 steals are only nine shy of the MLC single-season record.

Schultz previously won the award on November 20, 2017.
