

The UMAC released its Preseason Coaches' Polls for both softball and baseball last week. The softball team was picked to finish seventh in the conference this season, while the baseball team was picked ninth.

The softball team finished sixth in the UMAC in 2017 and returns a host of experience across the diamond. **Megan Lemke** (*Shoreland*) and **Kayla Rosenbaum** (*Michigan LHS*) return to lead the infield, while **Audrey Timm** (*Luther*) returns for her third season in center field.

The baseball team finished eighth in the conference last season and must replace several key seniors, but returns a lot of talent in the field and on the mound, led by outfielder **Caleb Christopher** (*MLS*) and pitcher **Adam Kock** (*LPS*).

MLC led by 10 points early in the game, but the Eagles knocked down 11 three-point field goals on the way to the 15-point win.

Sophomore **Richard Eckmann** (*Trimont MN*) led the Knights with a career-high 21 points on 8-12 shooting. Eckmann finished the season strong, scoring at least 13 points in each of his last six games.
