



Arndt Named UMAC Player of the Week after 28-24 Win

Senior wide receiver **Josh Arndt** (*SCLA*) was named UMAC Football Offensive Player of the Week following his performance in the Knights' 28-24 win at Rockford.

Arndt caught five passes for 120 yards and one touchdown in the game, including a 68-yard touchdown reception with under one minute to play in the fourth quarter to give the Knights the four-point lead.

Zach Bloomquist (*WISCO*), **Austin DeNoyer** (*Lakeside*), and **Nate Stein** (*LPS*) each added touchdown runs in the game, while **Ian Paulsen** (*LPS*) and **Ben Riegsecker** (*Nebraska LHS*) led the defense with 11 and 10 tackles, respectively.

The Beavers cut the deficit in half and pushed for the equalizer in the second half, but the MLC defense, led by senior keeper **Gabe Plocher** (*MLS*), kept them off the board the rest of the way to secure the MLC win.

MLC finished the game with a 28-17 advantage in total shots.

Lindemann Ties for Medalist Honor at UMAC Preview

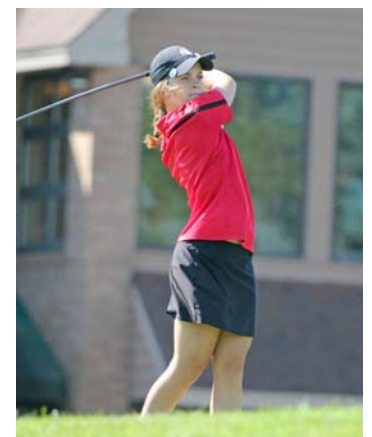

Lindemann tied with two other players for medalist honors at the event with a round of 91, helping the Knights to a tie for fifth place in the team competition. Lindemann currently ranks seventh among all UMAC women's golfers with an average round of 93.3 this season.

The men finished the event in sixth place, led by matching rounds of 82 by first-year players **Kyle Lindemann** (*LPS*) and **Stephen Biebert** (*LPS*).
