Alison Lindemann Named All-UMAC

Junior **Alison Lindemann** (*LPS*) became the first MLC women's golfer to earn All-UMAC honors following a seventh-place finish at last week's UMAC Golf Championships at Pebble Creek Golf Club.

Lindemann finished with a three-day score of 278 strokes. Her best round of the tournament came on Friday, when she shot 87 to tie for the lowest round of the day.

Lindemann recorded a 93.2 scoring average for the season, finishing seventh among all UMAC women's golfers. She also took home a pair of first-place finishes earlier this season at the UMAC Preview and UNW Invitational.

The men's soccer team snapped a 21-game losing streak (dating back to the 2006 season) to St. Scholastica with a 4-3 win on Saturday.

MLC trailed 2-1 at halftime, but a pair of goals by **Dan Wessel** (*MVL*) in the second half gave MLC a brief lead, and **Josh Thiesfeldt** (*WLA*) scored the game-winner in the 82nd minute off a pass from **Hugo Ugalde-Bemer** (*LPS*) to secure the win.

Wessel was named UMAC Defensive Player of the Week for his efforts and now has three goals this season.

The Knights sit in fourth place in the UMAC standings at the halfway point of the conference season with a 3-1-2 record.

The football team bumped its winning streak to four with a 28-21 come-from-behind win at Iowa Wesleyan on Saturday.
