The football team earned its first win over Northwestern-St. Paul since the 2009 season by the score of 21-6 on Friday, October 19.

The Knights jumped out to a 21-0 lead in the first half thanks to a pair of touchdowns (one rushing, one receiving) by **Austin DeNoyer** (*Lakeside*), as well as one rushing score by **Zach Bloomquist** (*WISCO*).

The defense took it from there, holding the Eagles to only six points and forcing four turnovers. **Ian Paulsen** (*LPS*) led the way with seven tackles, one sack, and one forced fumble. **Ben Arndt** (*SCLA*) and **Jared Witkowiak** (*WISCO*) each intercepted a pass.
