DeNoyer Named All-Region

Sophomore running back **Austin DeNoyer** (*Lakeside*) was named Third Team All-West Region by the website D3football.com on Tuesday.

DeNoyer was named UMAC Most Valuable Offensive Player after setting a new MLC single-season record for rushing yards (1,086), all-purpose yards (1,442), and rushing attempts (213). DeNoyer led the conference in all three statistics, as well as in rushing touchdowns (14) and total touchdowns (16). He also led the team in receptions (40) and ranked second in receiving yards (356).

DeNoyer is the first player in program history to be named All-Region by the website, and he is one of only three players in the UMAC to earn the honor this season.

The men's basketball team defeated Oak Hills Christian College 81-58 on Friday, November 30, to earn its second win of the season.

The Knights dominated the game from start to finish, scoring the first eight points of the game and building a lead as big as 30 points on the way to the win.

All 16 available players played in the game, helping the Knights outscore the Wolfpack bench 43-1. MLC assisted on 28 of its 32 baskets during the game.

Austin DeNoyer (*Lakeside*) led the Knights with 12 points, and was joined in double figures by **Nate Lindloff** (*MLS*) with 10 points. **Ian Paulsen** (*LPS*) recorded a career-high nine assists.
