The men's basketball team finished 2018 with wins over UW-Superior and Marian, but it's still looking for its first victory in 2019.

The Knights opened the new year with a close loss at St. Scholastica, and followed that up with tough defeats against Maranatha and Minnesota Morris before falling to Northwestern-St. Paul on Saturday, January 12.

MLC leads the UMAC in points allowed per game (70.4) during UMAC play and has held opponents to just 28.6 percent from beyond the three-point arc during conference action. Junior forward **Ian Paulsen** (*LPS*) leads the UMAC in blocks per game (2.0) while ranking third in steals per game (1.9).

Timm earned First Team All-UMAC honors in centerfield in 2018 after hitting .396 with four home runs, 22 runs batted in, and 21 runs scored.
